Transportation

You are responsible for your own transportation and cost. Denali is 4 hours north of Anchorage and 2 hours south of Fairbanks. If you are arriving in your own vehicle we are located at Mile 224 on the George Parks Hwy. Just look for the Creekside sign! If you are considering the drive we highly recommend it.

Having a vehicle is a luxury in Denali and is great for adventuring in your off time!



If you do not have your own transportation you can take the [Park Connection](#) or [Alaska Yukon Trails Shuttle](#) from either Anchorage or Fairbanks. They offer discounts for employees travelling to Denali. When booking your ticket be sure to let them know you are an employee as both companies offer significant discounts. The shuttle picks up at hostels. Based on our past employee's experiences we recommend **Base Camp Hostel** or **Arctic Adventure Hostel**.

Hostel not your thing? The shuttle also picks up at the **Egan Center** in Downtown Anchorage, a short walk from several hotels. Connect with others on the Facebook Group – Creekside Crew while you make your plans. Many staff members travel on the same days. You may meet some fellow Creeksiders on your way to us!

We recommend flying into Anchorage, staying at a hostel, and taking the shuttle to Denali the next morning. The shuttle will also stop by the grocery store on the way north so you can stock up on some supplies/food. ***Take advantage of this! Getting to the grocery store in Denali is not always easy and you will want to have a few meals for when you first arrive before the first grocery trip.**
